INTRODUCTION:

Pursuant to Section 101.12, Wisconsin Statures, this Town Board of the Town of Sugar Creek does hereby ordain a building code for public buildings as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A BUILDING CODE FOR PUBLIC BUILDINGS BY ADOPTION OF WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE CHAPTERS: ILHR 50, 51, 52, 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61, 62, 63 and 64.

1.1 ADOPTION OF WISCONSIN BUILDING AND HEATING, VENTILATING AND AIR CONDITIONING CODE

This Ordinance is hereby created to read as follows:

- (1) Chapter ILHR 50-64, Wisconsin Administrative Code, adopted and effective January 1, 1990, and all amendments thereto, are adopted and incorporated by reference.
- (2) The Building Inspector, as certified by the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations, is hereby athorized and directed to administer and enforce all of the provisions of the Wisconsin Building and Heating, Ventilating and Air Conditioning Code.

1.2 BUILDING PERMIT REQUIRED

No person shall build or cause to be built any new public building containing less than 50,000 cubic feet in total volume or alter a public building with less than 100,000 cubic feet in total volume, without first obtaining a building permit for such building. Such building permit shall be furnished by the Town upon approval of required drawings, specifications and calculations. A copy of such permit issued shall be filed with the town building department.

1.3 BUILDING PERMIT FEE

The building permit fee shall be determined by the Town Board.

1.4 PENALTIES

The Town Board shall provide for the enforcement of this section and all other laws and ordinances relating to building by means of withholding of building permits, imposition of forfeitures and injuncture action. (As according to Section 62.23(9), Wis. Stats.)
