The April 1, 2020, Sugar Creek Special Town Board Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m., at the town hall, by Chairman, Dale Wuttke.

There was 1 visitor present.

All Town Board Members were present Chairman-Wuttke, Supervisor - Robers and Clarbour, Treas.-Loveless and Clerk-Boyd. David Clarbour arrived late at 6:45. Also present was Attorney, Steve Koch.

Pumping of Lake Wandawega for flooding concerns. Attorney, Steve Koch has looked into this issue. His opinion was that this has to be bid because its going to be over \$25,000. If the Town purchased the equipment it would be \$60,000-\$70,000, the equipment materials and supplies would be over \$5,000. Steve discussed public facilities vs public work.. Chis Adday has checked into grants and funds, none are available for this solution. He did get two estimates. One from Lincoln Contractors and one from Sunbelt. The first is through a contractor and the second is for a rental of equipment. Going through a contractor is significantly higher. Approx. 18-20 residents are directly effected at this point. David Robers made a motion to have the Clerk and the Treasurer look into loan possibilities to cover the cost of the project (approx. \$100,000) to lower the lake; Clarbour seconded; motion carried unanimously.
