

The Jan. 18, 2021, Sugar Creek Town Board Meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m., at the town hall, by Chairman, Dale Wuttke.

There were 2 visitors present.

All open meeting laws have been complied with for this meeting.

All of the Town Board Members were present: Chairman-Wuttke, Supervisor - Robers and Clarbour, Clerk-Boyd and Treasurer-Loveless. Also present was Attorney, Steve Koch.

The minutes from the Dec. 21, 2020 Town Board Meeting were approved as presented. Motion made by David Robers and seconded by Clarbour; motion carried unanimously.

The Treasurer's Report was reviewed with \$1,843,640.88 in cash assets as of 01-18-21.

Fire Chief's Report. The Chief was not present. No Report.

The road report was presented by Greg Walbrandt. Things are going well this year. Ben Clark is doing an awesome job. The new truck is at Lakeside, the problems should be covered by warranty.

Request from Pam Travis to vacate a portion of Shore Lane between GNLE 00007, GNLE 00008, GNLE 00009 and GNLE 00010. The Plan Commission approved provided Steve has the paperwork. David Clarbour made a motion to approve the vacating of a portion of the roadway per the above request subject to the Town Engineer providing a legal description of the area to be vacated; Robers seconded; motion carried unanimously.

Unsanitary debris complaints at N6585 Forest Road. There has been no changes to the property since last month. Steve Koch has had contact with the property owner and they will have the vehicles moved and he intends to sell the property this spring. David Clarbour made a motion to have the Sheriff's Department liaison handle the complaint; Robers seconded; motion carried unanimously.

Revaluation for 2021, notices, open book and BOR dates. The Board discussed the revaluation, they reviewed the proposed information pamphlet. The date for open book was proposed for July 1st, the Clerk will talk to Accurate about moving that date. The Board thought that too many people may be gone due to the long 4th of July holiday that weekend.


