Purchase of a new computer for Town shop. Greg Walbrandt has talked with the Kalt Computers. The hard drive is going out on Greg's computer, to replace would be approx. \$1,200. David Robers made a motion to approve up to \$1,200 for a new computer; Clarbour seconded; motion carried unanimously.

Unightly debris complaints at N6585 Forest Road. There has been not changes to the property since last month. Dale Wuttke has talked to our new police liaison about this issue. The new police liaison will work on getting this property cleaned up.
