















To find a DMV, call us (844) 588-1069</li> <li>2) Bring the following, if available: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Proof of name and date of birth (such as a Birth Certificate)</li> <li>• Proof of identity (Social Security Card, Medicaid/Medicare card, etc.)</li> <li>• Wisconsin residency (Utility Bill, Government Mail, Lease, etc.)</li> <li>• Proof of U.S. citizenship (U.S. Birth certificate or Citizenship paperwork)</li> <li>• Social Security Number</li> </ul> </li> <li>3) If you don't have all or any of these... you can still get an ID for voting. 
